

## **Putney Prizes rules**

## Purpose

The purpose of Putney Prizes is to raise funds for the Putney Labour party. The money will be paid into the local Labour Party's treasury account and used to support all the party's campaigning activity, including the costs of literature, office equipment and operational costs

## Rules

- 1. For a cost of £10 per month (i.e. per draw) you will be allocated an entry into the draw.
- 2. A draw will be made every month with multiple prizes. It will be held at the monthly General Committee meeting except in August and December, and during purdah, when meetings are not held. In these circumstances two Executive Committee Officers and one 'ordinary' member of the CLP shall make the draw.
- 3. The prizes will total 50% of the monthly income up to a maximum of £500. Each month there will be one large prize and several smaller prizes. The Executive Committee will exercise discretion over the number and relative size of the prizes, with the aim of providing those who participate with a chance of winning one prize each year.
- 4. Putney Prizes is a Small Society lottery open to anyone over the age of 16yrs.
- 5. Payments must be made by standing order no later than the 28<sup>th</sup> of the month proceeding the draw, i.e. the 28<sup>th</sup> February 2023 for the draw to be made at the General Committee in March 2023. Members will only be entered if their subscription is up to date.
- 6. The winning prizes will be transferred to the bank account you supplied when you applied to join Putney Prizes within one week of the draw. You can only win a maximum of one time each month.
- 7. The name of each month's winners will be publicised in the party communications with local party members and members of the public who have entered the lottery..
- 8. Putney Prizes will be run by the Putney Constituency Labour party. In case of any dispute the decision of the Labour Party is final.
- 9. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the membership list if his/her subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of one month.
- 10. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into Putney Labour Party funds after six months.
